Dear Families,

Again it is time to look ahead and plan for Hebrew School - next year! We are looking forward to the 5779-80 school year already as we have so many ideas to extend our programs, lessons, and celebrations from what we have done this year. However, none of our plans can be realized without children in the rooms to bring it all to life! We need you to let us know what your plans are and make your commitment to DRRS so we can solidify our staffing, physical upgrades, and supplies. It is important to us to continue to show our success by being prepared for all our children; this can only be done well when we have an idea of who to expect and how to begin preparing for your children's needs.

Our schedule for the fall is:

1. Our kindergarten, first, and second grade will come on Sundays only. All Sunday classes will continue to begin at 9:30 and end at 12:30. We will provide a small morning snack for all the children (food allergies will be taken into consideration when planning snacks).
2. Third, fourth, fifth, and sixth grade will continue to meet on Sundays and Wednesdays. There will be no change in the Wednesday class times; class begins promptly at 5:00pm and ends at 6:30pm. We will open the classrooms at 4:45 for snack until 5:00 when class begins.
3. The seventh graders will only meet on Sundays; they will be working with their B'nai Mitzvah tutors during the week.
4. For seventh graders with little or limited Hebrew school experience, we will offer an additional Wednesday class designed to solidify their skills in order for them to fully participate in their Bar/Bat Mitzvah service.

Attached you will find the registration form for your child/ren and the two payment plans available for next year. We have not raised tuition in over ten years; however, with the rising cost of operating our religious school, we must do so now.

We are no longer collecting registration fees. We are now collecting tuition in two ways: paid in full by July 15, 2019 or 10 payments. If you choose to make payments, the first is one-tenth due to DRRS by July 15, 2019. Nine more payments will be collected from September through May via credit card or check.

- Please note that all tuition and dues must be current in order to hold a Bar Mitzvah or Bat Mitzvah at Kol Shalom.
